**SOUTH ROAD UPGRADE / ANZAC HIGHWAY UNDERPASS PROJECT - TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE**

I wish to advise you that as part of the South Road Upgrade and ANZAC Highway Underpass project, Garfield Avenue, Kurralta Park will be temporarily closed at the South Road end from Friday, 7 December until middle of 2008 (approximately).

During this period, works associated with implementing the diversion at Brown Hill Creek will be taking place.

Please note that pedestrian access will also be restricted until the beginning of 2008. Pedestrian access to South Road and Bus Stop 5 will continue to be made available via Tennyson Street and the current pedestrian arrangements at Mortimer Street.

Detour signage will be placed in vicinity of the road closure advising motorists and pedestrians of the changed traffic conditions. Emergency Services have been notified of these arrangements.

The City of West Torrens has given approval for this temporary, long term road closure to be implemented. These road closures are seen to provide the following benefits:

- Increased safety to local residents and workers while construction activities are in progress.
- Non-local traffic will be deterred from using these side streets to avoid the intersection.

We apologise if these arrangements cause any inconvenience to residents.
