SOUTH ROAD UPGRADE / ANZAC HIGHWAY UNDERPASS PROJECT – TRAFFIC SIGNAL WORKS IN PREPARATION FOR STAGE 1 TRAFFIC DIVERSIONS

I wish to advise you that as part of the South Road Upgrade and ANZAC Highway Underpass project traffic signal works will be taking place between Friday 16th and Sunday 25th November in preparation for the Stage 1 traffic diversion to be implemented by the end of November 2007.

These works will involve removing and relocating a number of traffic signal poles in temporary positions for the Stage 1 traffic diversion. The traffic signal poles currently located inside of the central medians on ANZAC Highway will need to be relocated temporarily in the current right turn lanes on Anzac Highway at the South Road intersection.

This will result in the following restrictions:

- No right turns will be permitted from ANZAC Highway onto South Road (heading north) from Friday 16 November until the middle of 2009 (approximately).
- No right turns will be permitted from ANZAC Highway onto South Road (heading south) from Friday 23 November until the middle of 2009 (approximately).
- No pedestrian access will be provided over ANZAC Highway on the western side of South Road at the intersection.

Pedestrians will be able to cross ANZAC Highway:

- on the western side of South Road via a pedestrian refuge near Selby Street Kurralta Park; and
- on the eastern side of South Road via traffic signal at the intersection.

These traffic arrangements are consistent with the Stage 1 Construction Plan that was released for public viewing in the July 2007 Community Update and is on display at the Home Ideas Centre and also available on the project website at www.adelaideconnect.com.au.

One lane of traffic may be restricted at times while traffic signals works are in progress around the intersection during non-peak hours.

Stage 1 traffic diversions will be in place from the 25th November 2007. Three lanes into the City (inbound) and two lanes out of the City (outbound) will be maintained on ANZAC Highway during peak times. Two lanes of traffic on South Road in both directions and right turn movements from South Road onto ANZAC Highway will also be maintained during peak times.
