SOUTH ROAD UPGRADE / ANZAC HIGHWAY UNDERPASS PROJECT - PEDESTRIAN ACCESS RESTRICTIONS IN BASNETT STREET

I wish to advise you that as part of the South Road Upgrade and ANZAC Highway Underpass project pedestrian access to South Road from Basnett Street Kurralta Park will be unavailable from Wednesday 21st November until the middle of 2008 (approximately) when the completion of the northbound entry ramp is scheduled.

With a number of work activities in progress or due to commence in this area, the pedestrian access restrictions have been determined due to safety reasons.

Pedestrian access to South Road will continue to be made available via Garfield Avenue. A small pedestrian bridge off Basnett Street at the Beauchamp Street intersection can be accessed for this purpose and is also lit for night usage. Bus Stop 5 can also be accessed via Garfield Avenue.

Good signage will be in place providing advance warning to pedestrians of the changed access arrangements.
