PLEASE READ: IMPORTANT INFORMATION

SOUTH ROAD UPGRADE / ANZAC HIGHWAY UNDERPASS – TELSTRA WORKS

As would be aware, the Telstra Corporation has been working in the vicinity of South Road and Anzac Highway intersection recently to relocate network facilities in preparation for the construction of the underpass.

Due to some unforeseen difficulties, not all of the scheduled activities were able to be undertaken in the timeframe anticipated. Works have now been rescheduled to take place on Anzac Highway, at various locations both east and west of South Road, from Warwick Avenue, Kurralta Park to just past Berkley Avenue, Everard Park on Saturday 4 August from 7 am through to 7 pm on Sunday 5 August 2007.

As a result of these works, traffic will be reduced to one lane travelling on Anzac Highway in both directions at these locations. Left hand turns from Anzac Highway onto South Road will be restricted to one lane for southbound motorists.

Traffic controllers, reduced speed limits and advanced traffic signage will be in place advising motorists of these traffic restrictions.

Night time works will be undertaken in accordance with Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) guidelines and managed to ensure noise impacts to local residents are minimised. Measures to be implemented to reduce impacts to local residents during night works include: conduct of noisiest activities during daytime hours; minimising the number of vehicles on site; and instructing work personnel to avoid talking and walking through back streets at night.
