SOUTH ROAD UPGRADE/ANZAC HIGHWAY UNDERPASS PROJECT – 15 March asphaltting works on Anzac Highway between Waltham and Selby Streets postponed until 29 March 2008.

I wish to advise you that due to the forecast extreme heat conditions on Saturday 15 March 2008, preparation works to switch traffic onto new asphalt on the south-western side of ANZAC Highway at the South Road intersection has been postponed until **Saturday 29 March 2008...**

As noted in previous correspondence, these works will include temporary asphaltting, line marking and pavement installation on the existing westbound carriageway.

Revised Times of Works: from 7.00am until 8pm on Saturday 29 March 2008.

Traffic Restrictions: From 6am 29 March 2008 until traffic is diverted onto the new alignment traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction on the northern carriageway of ANZAC Highway between Waltham Street and Selby Street.

Depending on the work progress and weather conditions, traffic restrictions on the westbound carriageway (to Glenelg) on ANZAC Highway may continue to be in place until 6am Monday 31 March 2008, or until such time as the new asphalt is cool enough to accommodate traffic.

Access to all business and residential properties will be maintained. Traffic controllers will be onsite to assist where required. No traffic will be diverted into the local streets.

Variable Messages Signs (VMS) and other traffic signage will be in place advising motorists of all traffic restrictions on ANZAC Highway and speed limits will apply.
