

CHANGES IN TRAFFIC CONDITIONS FROM 15 OCTOBER 2007

In preparation for construction of the southern underpass ramps, traffic conditions along South Road between Forest Street and ANZAC Highway, Glandore will change from Monday 15 October 2007.

Traffic Restrictions

The left turn lane on South Road heading west to Glenelg will be closed to motorists until completion of the new bridge deck in the middle of 2009 (approximately). Two through lanes on South Road heading north and right turn lanes onto ANZAC Highway for city bound traffic will still be maintained. The western footpath on South Road between Forest Street and ANZAC Highway will also be closed during this period.

Forest Street, Glandore will be permanently closed at the South Road end and no traffic will be able to enter or exit Forest street from South Road.

The Public Transport Division, Cities of West Torrens and Unley, Emergency Services and Baptist Church have been notified about these changes. These arrangements are consistent with the Stage One Construction Plans which were included in the July Community Update and are also on display at the Home Ideas Centre and in Council offices.

These traffic restrictions are being implemented to ensure safety for the public and road workers is maintained while major construction works are in progress. The closure of Forest Street will also eliminate the use of this street by non-local traffic and reduce disturbance to residents.

Variable Message Signs (VMS) and other traffic signage will be in place advising motorists of the changed traffic conditions. We apologise for any inconvenience caused to motorists and pedestrians as a result of these changes.
