***SOUTH ROAD UPGRADE/ANZAC HIGHWAY UNDERPASS -
NOTICE OF WORKS ON SATURDAY 2 AND SUNDAY 3 JUNE
2007***

In preparation for relocation of telecommunications infrastructure and the commencement of construction of the underpass later in 2007, minor road works will be taking place on South Road between Glengyle Terrace, Glandore and Tennyson Street, Kurralta Park, on Saturday 2 June 2007 from 7am to 6pm and on Sunday 3 June 2007 from 9am to 6pm.

These works will involve the removal of the solid median on South Road and replacing it with painted line markings. Line marking activities may extend into Sunday evening; however this activity is not expected to cause any major traffic or noise disruptions.

Some daytime construction noise can be expected along South Road and possibly into nearby side streets while works to remove the solid median are in progress. All works will be conducted in accordance with Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) guidelines. Most noise generating construction activities are also expected to be completed on Saturday 2nd June 2007.

To accommodate these works, some temporary traffic restrictions on South Road will be implemented as follows:

- Saturday 2 June 2007 – one lane will be closed to traffic in each direction along South Road between Glengyle Terrace and Anzac Highway.
- Sunday 3 June 2007 – one lane will be closed in each direction on South Road between Anzac Highway and Tennyson Street.

Some minor traffic restrictions may also apply for short periods on Anzac Highway near the intersection as medians are modified slightly.

Reduced speed limits and advance traffic signage, including Variable Message Signs (VMS) warning motorists of these traffic restrictions will be in place.

Other works to also occur during the next couple of weeks include:

- removal of the pedestrian refuge in the southern central median on South Road, between Eurilpa Avenue and Forest Street;
- relocation of the pedestrian refuge in the central median south of Eurilpa Avenue further south, closer to Norman and Glengyle Terrace and the tramline; and
- temporary closure of bus stop 6a on the western side of South Road near Forest Street, while median removal works are underway. Further temporary closures of this bus stop may also be necessary to accommodate the relocation of telecommunications infrastructure during June 2007.

We apologise if these works cause you any inconvenience and we will make every effort to minimise any impacts on local residents, businesses and community groups.
