**SOUTH ROAD UPGRADE / ANZAC HIGHWAY UNDERPASS PROJECT-
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE FOR TRENCHING WORKS**

I wish to advise you that as part of the South Road Upgrade and ANZAC Highway Underpass project, trenching works to relocate services such as telecommunications, electricity and gas will be continuing across Garfield and Tennyson Streets at the South Road end on the dates outlined below:

- **Garfield Street – from Thursday 23 August 2007 for a period of approximately 1 – 2 weeks.**
- **Tennyson Street – from Monday 27 August 2007 until mid September 2007.**

No entry will be allowed to these streets via South Road while works are in progress. Temporary 'road closed' and 'detour' signage will be in place during these periods. Through traffic, travelling in an easterly direction along Garfield and Tennyson Streets will be diverted up Beauchamp Street. Local access will however, be maintained for residents between Beauchamp Street and South Road during this period. If for some reason access to properties closest to South Road on Garfield and Tennyson Streets will be temporarily restricted at any time, you will be contacted by a member of the project team at least 24 hours prior, to discuss access arrangements with you.

The 241 bus route will also be temporarily diverted from Monday 27 August until mid September. Bus stops 4A on both sides of Tennyson Street will be unavailable during this period and temporary bus stops placed in Beauchamp Street.

Signage will be placed in vicinity of the existing bus stop 4A locations, advising passengers of the changed traffic conditions.
